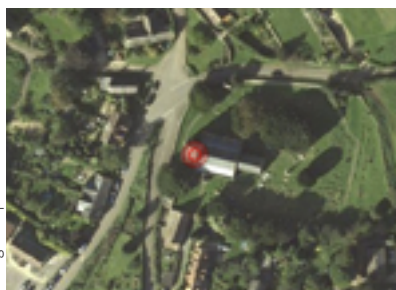

There will be opportunity to record 'collect' sounds that you find interesting, characteristic, out of place or even beautiful. The artists will then lead an afternoon workshop, introducing the participants to simple sound editing and uploading to the radio aporee maps projects.

World Listening Day provides an opportunity for engaging in listening to soundscapes and sharing the experience.
